Wilson Hoyles Perfect Game July 21, 2009

On July 21, 2009 Wilson Hoyles of the Brampton Men's Horseshoe Club pitched a perfect game. He pitched 8 ringers for 8 shoes and his partner Barry Turnbull pitched 5 ringers for 8 shoes, to lead his team to a 35 to 3 victory.

This is only the third time in the club's 32 year history that this has happened. The first one was in 1999 by Jim Dament and the second was in 2002 by Clyde Smoke.



The players witnessing this historical event said each shoe pitched, was a perfect shoe, not one slid or fluke on.

Wilson joined our club in 2008 and started in the "C" Division, but quickly established himself as an "A" division player; his final average for the year was 29.8% it could have been higher, but a serious injury to his pitching hand made it difficult to throw the last two weeks. He helped his team the Wannabees to a third place finish.
