improve the Park and how the club operates.**



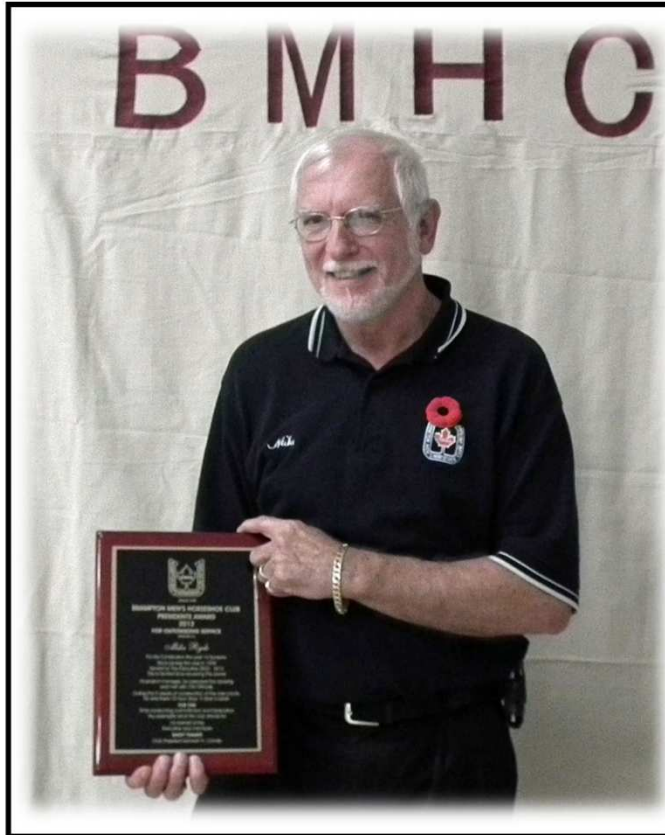
**Note: Ken was re-elected by acclamation, for the year 2014 and 2015, he is the longest
