ELWOOD PEMBLETON MEMORIAL AWARD MOST IMPROVED PLAYER



1921 – 2007

Elwood was the co-founder of our club and in 2000 inducted into the Ontario Horseshoe Hall of Fame, in 2003 received the City of Brampton Citizen Award for 25 years of service. He was the driving force behind the development of our club, and served as President for two terms and served in all other capacities, in 2002 he was appointed Club Advisor & Goodwill Ambassador. He died suddenly on November 14, 2007 after knee replacement surgery. A memorial garden was built in 2008 near the horseshoe pits, and the path leading through the park was named the Elwood Pembleton Way. "He will be missed, but never forgotten."
