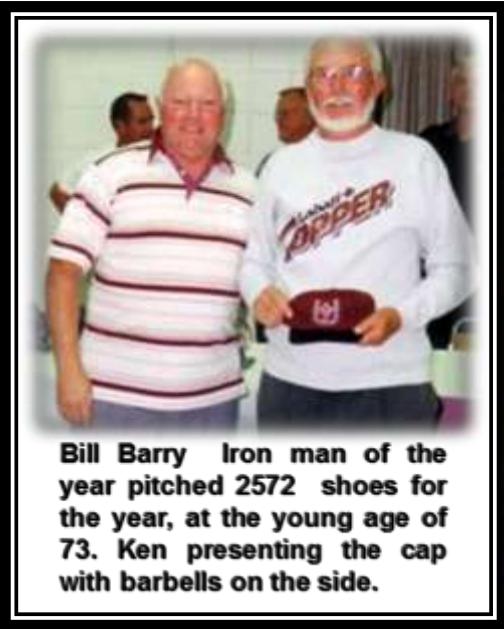


2014 Iron Man of the Year
