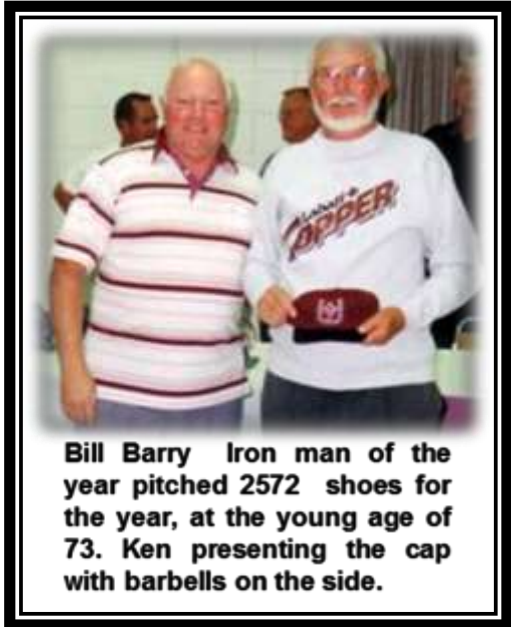


2017 Iron Man of the Year
