In 2003 he put his skills to a test and drew up the plans, help build the clubhouse, and in 2007 & 2011 designed and help build a total of three picnic shelters, in both those years he received the President's Award for his hard work and dedication.

The ultimate climax to all of his years, serving the club was this past year, drawing up the plans, helping in the negotiations with the City and then spending countless hours overseeing the work of the contractor, as well as help build the new backboards, planter box and cutting and installing the rubber.
